YOUR WARRANTY AND OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION.

Limited Warranty

L & W warrants that this sleep will be free from defects in material and workmanship as described in this Limited Warranty.

Length of Warranty

This warranty begins on the day you purchase your sleep set. If your sleep set is repaired or replaced, this limited warranty will not be renewed or extended. Please refer to the "warranty Schedule" found in this warranty to determine the length of your warranty.

The Warranty Covers...

Only the following items during normal wear:

Mattress: Coils or wires that are loose or broken. Coils or wires that protrude or rip through any fabric. Body indentations of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " or greater on both sides. Excessively lumpy feel. Sagging, but only when a mattress has been continuously supported by a matching foundation (or equivalent) with an appropriate frame and center support having at least 5 legs Full/Queen/King Must have center support. (see illustration for clarification)

Foundation: Splitting of wood frame. Squeaks, rattles, or noises. Bent, loose or defective beam and/or center support rail. Loose or broken foundation wire. Compression of modules. Sagging, but only when a mattress has been continuously supported by a matching foundation (or equivalent) with an appropriate frame and center support having at least 5 legs Full/Queen/King Must have center support. (see illustration for clarification)

This Warranty Does Not Cover:

Items not specifically listed in the "This Warranty Covers" Section including, for example:

Fabric (including stains, soiling or burns). Handles (which should be only be used to position the mattress). Border wires, which run along the perimeter of the mattress and foundation, bent due to moving or bending the sleep set. Structural damage due to use of improper bed frame. This warranty applies to full, queen and king size mattress ONLY if used on a appropriate frame with a rigid center support having at least 5 legs Full/Queen/King Must have center support. Bedding sold "as is" and floor models. Bed height. Comfort preference. Body indentations of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " or greater on only one side. Body indentations of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " or greater on both sides. Mattress damage due to an inappropriate foundation. A mattress is designed for full performance when used in conjunction with a matching foundation as a part of a total sleep set. Sheet fit. Replacement of another piece in the sleep set, unless such other piece is also a defective. Mattress and foundation due to abuse. Transportation costs.

Full Cycle Rotation/Turning Instructions:

Body indentations are normal occurrence in your new mattress and indicate that the upholstery layers are conforming to your body's individual contours. To help minimize body impressions, please turn your mattress every two weeks in the first three months then refer to the turn labels at the foot of your mattress Continue this process throughout the life of your sleep set. **WARNING:** Do not attempt to turn the mattress by yourself. This may cause personal injury or damage to your mattress. Handles should only be used to position the mattress. They may pull out if used to support the full weight of the mattress.

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Limited Warranty Continued

If a Warranty Problem Occurs...

In the unlikely event that a defect that is covered in this warranty occurs with your new mattress or foundation, contact the local retail store that you purchased your sleep set. If a defect that is covered occurs during the no-charge period (at our option) the defective mattress and or foundation within a reasonable time period. If a problem occurs after the no-charge period, but prior to the end of warranty period, L & W will repair or replace (again, at our option) the defective product with a charge to you as determined from the warranty schedule. In order for this limited warranty to be valid you must be the original consumer purchaser from one of L & W's retail stores. You must provide a copy of the original store receipt or other proof of date, place purchased and purchase price. If identical materials are not available at the time of product service, L & W reserves the right to substitute material of equal or higher value, or, at our option, provide a refund. You must pay transportation costs for the product to and from the store or the factory, as applicable. L & W reserves the right to refuse service and invalidate this warranty when, upon inspection the sleep set is found to be in an unsanitary condition or when product failure is due to causes other than defective workmanship or materials.

Exclusive Remedy/Other Limitations

Any and all implied warranties on this product, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, shall not exceed in duration the term of this limited warranty which begins with the date of purchase by the consumer. The service terms stated in this warranty shall be the consumer's sole and exclusive remedy in the event of product failure during the warranty period. L & W will not be liable for incidental or consequential damages arising out of the use or inability to use this product, or for the breach of this and any other express or implied warranty. L & W does not warrant that this product is suitable for any person's medical condition. L & W makes no warranty beyond what is contained in this writing.

Do's & Don'ts of Bedding Care

DO: Turn your mattress frequently. The materials used in this mattress are designed to conform to your body's individual contours. Turn your mattress every two weeks in the first three months to maximize its conformance to your body. It is your responsibility to turn the mattress in this manner to ensure validation and compliance with these warranty provisions. **DO** give your new sleep set time to "air" upon removal from its plastic packaging. Dispose of all plastic packaging as soon as possible. **DO** carry your mattress flat on its side. It's easier to handle and less likely to damage the mattress. **DO** keep your bedding clean. We suggest using a mattress pad, especially if children use the bed. **DO** replace the foundation when buying a new mattress. An old foundation may not provide sufficient support. It may appear that your new mattress is sagging when it is really the foundation which supports the entire mattress. **DO** use an appropriate frame and center support for full, queen and king sets. Using a support frame will validate your warranty.

DON'T: **DON'T** place near open flame or near fire. This mattress is not flame or fire proof and can ignite and/or burn rapidly and emit smoke and hazardous gases. **DON'T** smoke in bed. This mattress is manufactured as required by federal law to resist, but not necessarily eliminate, ignition by smoldering cigarettes. **DON'T** carry mattress using handles. Use handles to position mattress on foundation. **DON'T** let anyone stand or jump on your mattress. It was not built for that kind of weight concentration. **DON'T** place a board between your mattress and foundation. Your sleep set is designed specifically to provide you with support. **DON'T** bend your mattress under any circumstances. Such treatment may damage the inner spring unit. Flex rather than bend the mattress when going through doorways, and don't bend the corners when putting on fitted sheets. **DON'T** remove the labels from your mattress. This serves as a means for important information. **DON'T** use dry cleaning fluid of any type on your mattress. These chemicals will damage some of the construction materials.
